

AN ACT to authorise the Reappropriation of certain Unexpended Balances of Loan Moneys and the Application thereof for the purposes of making provision for certain State Liabilities and to provide for the Adjustment of the Accounts of the Treasury relating thereto. [14 December, 1931.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Loan Funds Adjustment Act, Short title. 193."

Reappropriation of amounts in schedule.

Application of moneys reappropriated. 17 Geo. V. No. 67. Adjustments.

- 2 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate and apply for the purposes of this Act the several sums set forth in the schedule hereto out of the respective balances of the amounts authorised by or raised under the Acts specified in that schedule and not required for the purposes thereof respectively, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Thirty-nine thousand six hundred Pounds.
- 3 The Treasurer shall apply the moneys reappropriated under this Act for the redemption of the debentures mentioned in Item 1 in the schedule to the Loans Act, 1926-27.
- 4 The Treasurer may cause such transfers and entries as he may consider necessary or desirable to be made in the books of the Treasury for the purpose of giving effect to the provisions of this Act.
