

AN ACT to amend "The Longford Lighting A.D. 1905. [20 November, 1905.] Act, 1903."

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 This Act may be cited as "The Longford Lighting\_Act Amend- Short title. ment Act, 1905;" and this Act and "The Longford Lighting Act, 1903," hereinafter called "the Principal Act," shall be read together.

2 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Amendment of Principal Act, it shall not be lawful for the Trustees to publish the Section Seven notice referred to in Sections Seven and Eight of that Act, nor shall the Poll referred to in Section Seven aforesaid be taken, unless the Trustees shall have previously received a Petition signed by not less than Two-thirds in number of the persons who are owners or occupiers of property, as shown by the Assessment Roll, situate within the area proposed to be added to the Light District, praying that the Light District may be made the same in size and area as the Longford Water District.

Amendment of Section Ten of Principal Act. Amendment of Section Four of Principal Act.

- 3 Section Ten of the Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after the word "may," in line One, the words "upon the Petition of the Municipal Council of Longford."
- 4 Section Four of the Principal Act is hereby amended by omitting in line Seven the word "Trusrees," and inserting the word "Trustees" in lieu thereof.
