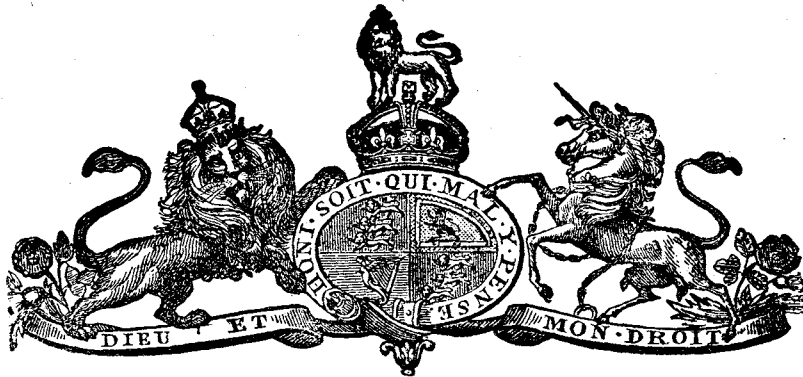

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Longford Lighting Loan Act, Short title.
1921."

2 In this Act—

"The Corporation" means the Warden, Councillors, and Electors of the Municipality of Longford :

"The Council" means the Council of the said Municipality.

"The Loans Act" means "The Local Bodies' Loans Act."

3 It shall be lawful for the Council, on behalf of the Corporation, to raise, by way of loan under "The Loans Act," the sum of One thousand Pounds by the sale of debentures, in accordance with the provisions of that Act, for the purposes set out in "The Longford Lighting Act, 1903."

4 The special resolution, passed by the Council on the Tenth day of September, One thousand nine hundred and twenty, and confirmed on the Fifteenth day of October in the same year, authorising the borrowing of the said sum of One thousand Pounds, shall be deemed to be a compliance in all respects with the provisions of "The Loans Act," requiring the adoption or making of a special resolution to authorise such borrowing, and all the provisions of "The Loans Act," requiring any notice to be published, or any poll to be taken, or any other matter or thing to be done prior to the passing, confirming, adoption, or making of such special resolution, shall be deemed to have been duly complied with at the time of the confirmation of such special resolution as aforesaid.

5 Subject as aforesaid all the provisions of "The Loans Act" shall apply to the said loan and to the debentures to be issued in respect thereof.
