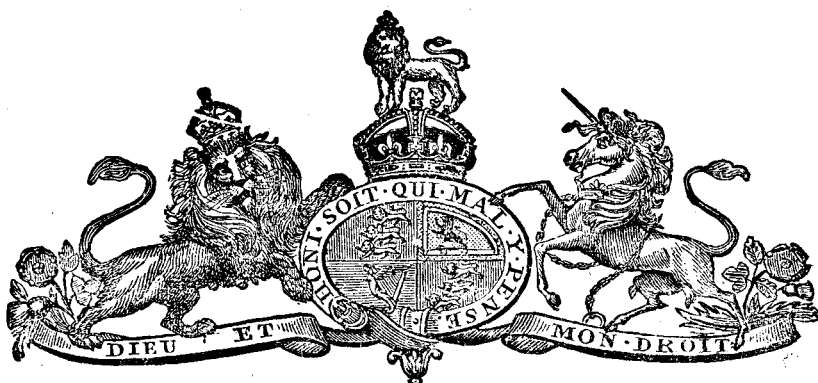

AN ACT to amend "The Leven Municipality
 Loan Act, 1920." [21 December, 1921.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Leven Municipality Loan Act, 1921." Short title.

2 Upon passing a special resolution for that purpose, in pursuance of the provisions of "The Local Government Act, 1906," it shall be lawful for the Council, on behalf of the Corporation, to borrow under the provisions of "The State Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1921," any further sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole One thousand five hundred Pounds, for the purposes of "The Leven Municipality Loan Act, 1920." 3 The amount payable by the Council as an annual contribution towards a sinking fund in respect of any moneys borrowed under this Act shall be a sum equal to One Pound per centum of the moneys so borrowed. Sinking fund.
