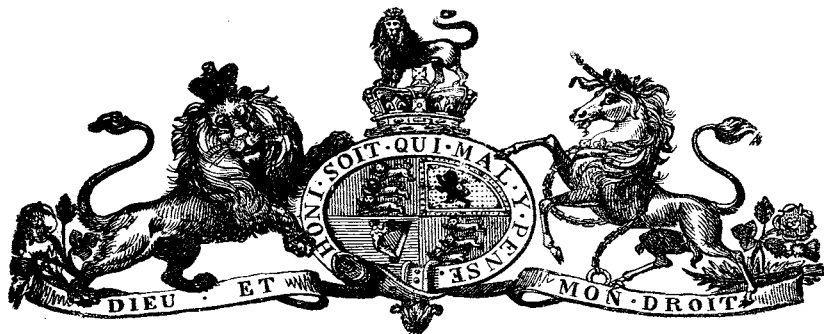

AN ACT to amend the *Launceston* Police A.D. 1890.
Provident Fund Act. [28 November, 1890.] —

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend “The *Launceston* Police PREAMBLE.
Provident Fund Act,” and extend the provisions of the same to all 41 Vict. No. 23.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The *Launceston* Police Provident Short title.
Fund Act, 1890.”

2 In this Act— Interpretation.
“The said Act” means “The *Launceston* Police Provident
Fund Act.”

4 All persons in the employ of the *Launceston* Municipal Council Nature and object.
when this Act comes into force may, and all thereafter appointed shall,
contribute of their pay to the maintenance of the *Launceston* Police
Provident Fund in like proportions as any Superintendent or other
Constable employed by the said Council is required to contribute, and
in return therefore shall be entitled to receive from the said Fund, for
and in respect of the years they have contributed, superannuation at
the same rate as any such Superintendent or other Constable would be
entitled to receive.
