

AN ACT to authorise the raising of Money A.D. 1873. for Local Public Works. [31 October, 1873.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide Money for payments to be PREAMBLE. made by the Colonial Treasurer in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Act, 1872:" 36 Vict. No. 18.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Money required for payments to be made by the Colonial Power to raise Treasurer in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Money by Deben-Act, 1872," shall be raised by the issue and sale of Debentures tures. chargeable on the General Revenue of Tasmania, which Debentures the Governor in Council is hereby authorised to issue and sell; and all the provisions of the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 20th Victoria, No. 9, shall apply to such Debentures.

2 This Act may be cited as "The Local Public Works Loans Act, Short title. 1873."
