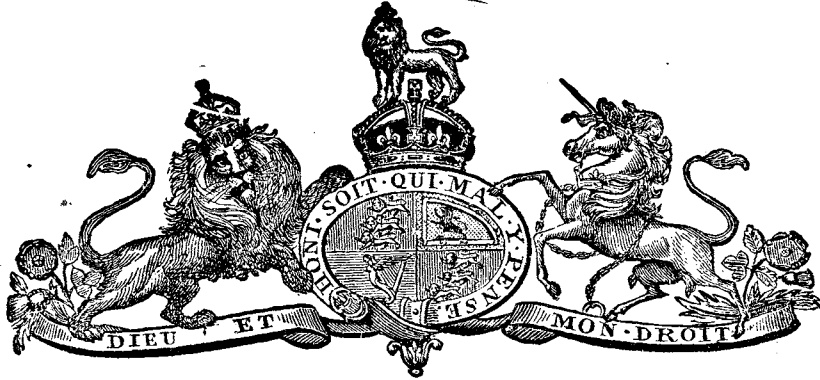

Cancellation of purchase-grants, &c.

AN ACT to re-vest in the Crown certain Allotments of Land situate at Derby, County of Dorset, Tasmania, registered in the name of The Tasmanian Tin Dredging Company Limited, now dissolved, and for other purposes. [13 November, 1919.]

WHEREAS Five allotments of land in the Town of Derby, County of Dorset, in Tasmania, and shown as Lots 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14, Section J, upon the plan of subdivision of the said town, were purchased from the Crown by and granted to the Tasmanian Tin Dredging Company Limited, (hereinafter referred to as "the said Company"), under Purchase Grants, Registered Volume LXXVIII, folios 111, 110, 109, 108, and 107:

PREAMBLE.

And whereas under or by virtue of Subsection (4) of Section Seven of the Imperial Act, intituled "The Companies Act, 1880," the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies, England, having reasonable cause to believe that the said Company was not carrying on business or in operation, struck the name of the said Company off the register and published a notice thereof in the "London Gazette," on the Second day of August, One thousand nine hundred and four, and thereupon the said Company by law became dissolved:

And whereas neither the said Company nor any other company or person whatsoever, either on behalf of the said Company or otherwise, has during the past Fifteen years exercised any acts of ownership, occupation, or possession with respect to the said allotments or any of them, and the said allotments are vacant allotments:

And whereas in the interests of the mining industry it is desirable that the said allotments should be re-vested in the Crown:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly in Parliament assembled as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as “The Land Re-Vesting Act, 1919.”

Interpretation.

2 In this Act “the said allotments” mean “Lots Ten, Eleven, Twelve, Thirteen, and Fourteen, of Section J, shown upon the plan of subdivision of the Town of Derby, County of Dorset, Tasmania, kept in the Department of Lands and Surveys, and which said lots are more particularly described in Purchase Grants, Registered Volume LXXVIII., Folios 111, 110, 109, 108, and 107 issued to and in the name of The Tasmanian Tin Dredging Company Limited and are delineated in the plan in the Schedule hereto and therein surrounded by red boundary lines.”

Re-vesting in His Majesty of the said allotments.

3—(1) On the passing of this Act the said allotments—

- i. Shall by force of this Act, and without the necessity of any transfer, revert to and re-vest in His Majesty the King, absolutely, freed and discharged from all estates, interests, trusts, limitations, encumbrances, and restrictions whatsoever: and
- ii. Shall be deemed to be and may be dealt with as unalienated lands of the Crown.

Cancellation of purchase-grants, &c.

(2) Every purchase grant or other instrument of title and the duplicates thereof, issued in respect of the said allotments, are hereby made void, revoked, and annulled, and the Recorder of Titles is hereby authorised and directed—

- i. To cancel the duplicate of every such purchase grant or other instrument in the register book in his office: and
- ii. To dispense with the production of any outstanding duplicate of any such purchase grant or other instrument.

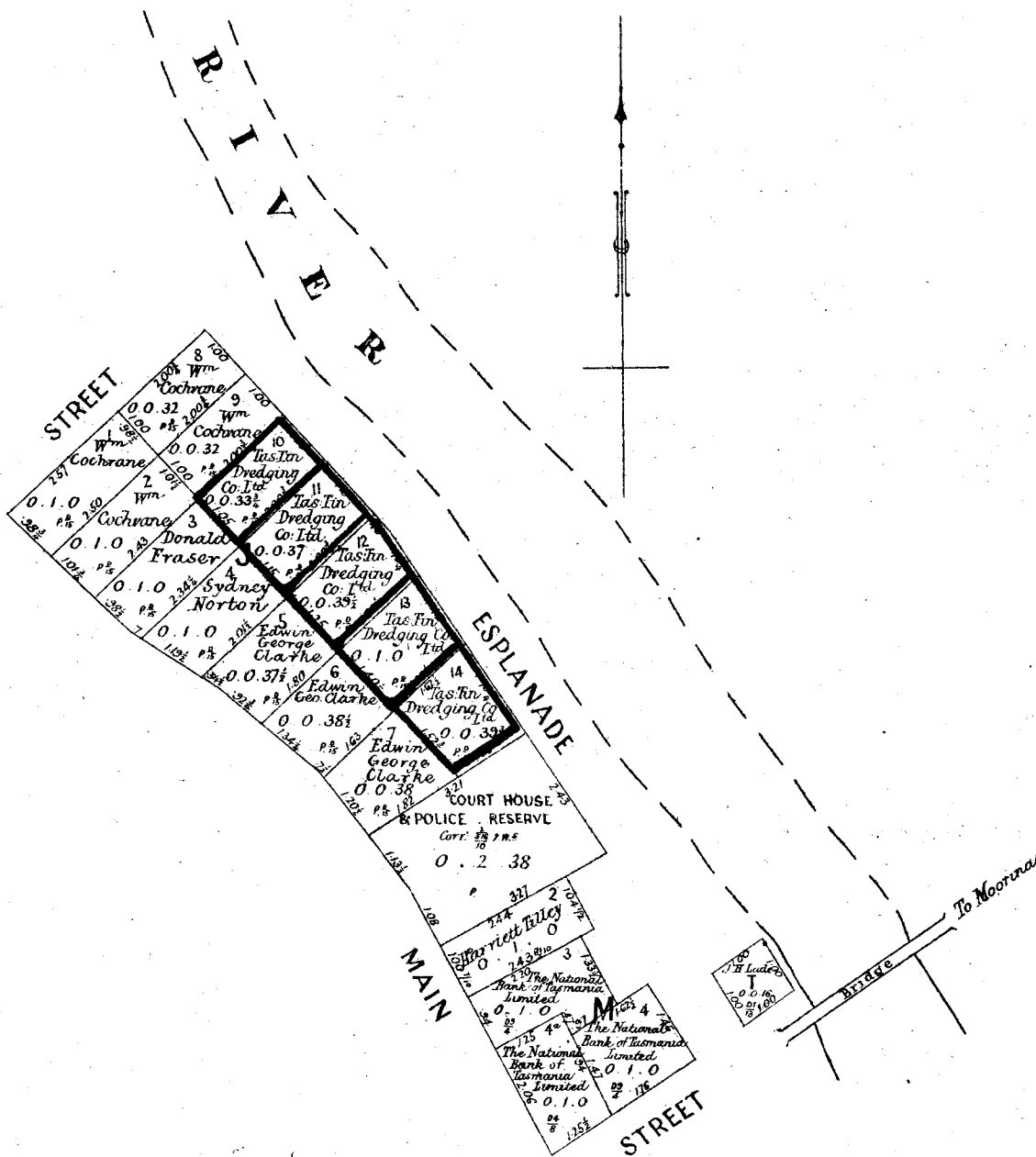
