

AN ACT to amend "The Land Surveyors Act, 1909." [6 December, 1924.] A.D. 1924.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Land Surveyors Act, 1924," and shall come into force on the First day of January, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-five. Short title.

(2) "The Land Surveyors Act, 1909," is herein called "the Principal Act." Principal Act. 9 Ed. VII No. 45.

2 Section Three of the Principal Act is hereby amended by expunging therefrom the definition of "Surveyor-General" contained in the said section. Amendment of Section 3 of the Principal Act.

Principal Act.**3** Section Four of the Principal Act is hereby amended as follows :—

- i. By repealing Subsection (2) thereof:
- ii. By renumbering Subsections (3) and (4) thereof as (2) and (3) respectively :
- iii. By inserting the following new subsection as Subsection (4) thereof :—

“(4) One other person, being an officer in the Public Service of the State, shall be appointed by the Governor to be a member of the Board and the President thereof, and he shall hold office as such member and President during the Governor’s pleasure” :

- iv. As to Subsection (6) thereof, by inserting after the word “ Board ” in the first line of the said subsection the words “ other than the President ” :
- v. As to Subsection (7) thereof, by deleting the words “ *ex officio* member ” in the second line of the said subsection and substituting the word “ President ” therefor : and
- vi. As to Subsection (10) thereof, by inserting after the word “ Board ” in the first line of the said subsection the words “ other than the President.”

Amendment of
Section 16 of the
Principal Act.

4 Section Sixteen of the Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the word “ Surveyor-General ” whenever it occurs therein, and substituting the words “ Permanent Head of the Lands and Surveys Department ” therefor.
