

## QUINQUAGESIMO-SECUNDO ANNO

AN ACT to enable the Municipal Council of A.D. 1888. the Town of Launceston to borrow any Sum or Sums of Money, not exceeding £25,000, for the purpose of improving and extending the Sewerage of the said Town.

[16 October, 1888.]

E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 It shall be lawful for the Municipal Council of the Town of Laun- Council emceston to borrow, on security of the Municipal Rates, other than the powered to borrow Police or Water Rates, any sum or sums of money not exceeding £25,000.

Twenty-five thousand Pounds, for the purpose of improving and extending the Sewerage of the said Town.

2 If, after having borrowed the said sum or sums, or any part Council emthereof, the said Council pays off the same, it shall be lawful for the powered to pay said Council again to borrow the amount so paid off, and so from time off and re-borrow. to time.

3 The sum or sums of money hereinbefore mentioned shall be in Loan to be in addition to any sum or sums of money borrowed by the said Municipal addition to former Council under the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 50th loans. Victoria, No. 2; and the provisions of The Launceston Corporation 22 Vict. No. 12. Act relating to Mortgages of Rates shall be applicable to any sum or sums of money borrowed under this Act.

4 This Act may be cited as "The Launceston Sewerage Act, No. 6." Short title.
