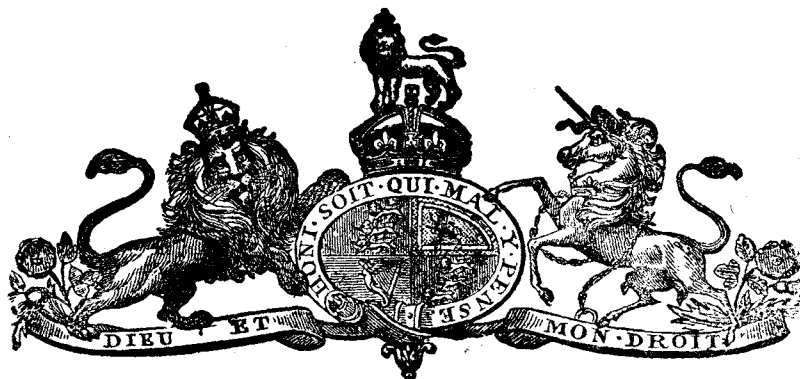

AN ACT to further amend "The Launceston Tramway Act, 1906." [28 October, 1915.] A.D. 1915.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Launceston Tramway Act, No. 6," and shall be incorporated and be read as one with "The Launceston Tramway Act, 1906"; "The Launceston Tramway Act, No. 2"; "The Launceston Tramway Act, No. 3"; "The Launceston Tramway Act, No. 4"; and "The Launceston Tramway Act, No. 5."

2 The words "refuses or neglects to pay, or does not pay his fare, or" are hereby inserted after the word "tramway" in the Second line of Section Thirty-nine of "The Launceston Tramway Act, 1906," and the words "refuses or neglects to pay, or" are inserted after the word "and" in the Fourth line of such section.

3 The words "or rule or regulation" are hereby inserted after the word "by-law" in the Second line of the Forty-third section of "The Launceston Tramway Act, 1906," and also in the Third line of the Forty-fourth section of the same Act.

5 The words "or other officer or servant of the promoters demanding the same on," occurring in that part of Section Twenty-eight of "The Launceston Tramway Act, 1906," which was inserted by Section Nine of "The Launceston Tramway Act, No. 5," are hereby expunged, and the word "of" is inserted in lieu thereof, and the words "or to some other officer or servant of the promoters demanding the same," are hereby inserted after the word "conveyed" at the end of the said Section Twenty-eight.

6 Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Police Act, 1905," or any other statute or law to the contrary, if any money, goods, or chattels are left in or near any conveyance, tram, or omnibus, or in or near any waiting-room, office, or other building used in connection with the tramways, and the owner thereof is not known, the Corporation may, without responsibility, take possession of the same and at any time or times thereafter cause it to be notified by advertisement in any newspaper published in the City of Launceston, that such money will be forfeited, or such goods or chattels will be sold upon a day named in such notice, not less than Twenty-six days from the publication thereof, and if such money, goods, or chattels are not claimed by and proved to belong to some person before such day, the said money may, if the Corporation so desires, without any act of the Corporation, be forfeited to, and shall on such forfeiture become the property of, the Corporation, or the said goods or chattels may, if the Corporation so desires, be sold and the net proceeds of such sale shall on such sale become the property of the Corporation.
