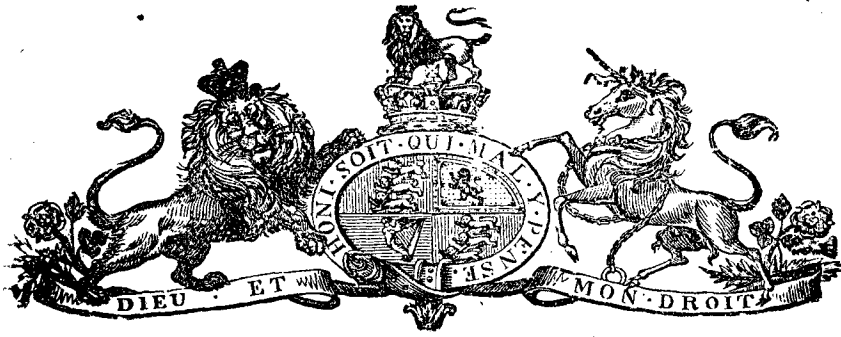

AN ACT to amend "An Act to make better provision for vesting in Her Majesty the Queen Land acquired for Roads and for other purposes." [29 October, 1898.] A.D. 1898.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Land Vesting Act, 1898." Short title.
- 2 The Act of Parliament 58 *Victoria*, No. 17, intituled "An Act to make better provision for vesting in Her Majesty the Queen Land acquired for Roads and for other Purposes," shall, by virtue of this Act, have the short title of "The Land Vesting Act, 1894," and may for all purposes be cited by that short title, and shall in this Act be referred to as "the said Act." Short title and Interpretation of 58 Vict. No. 17.
- 3 Whenever any Minister of the Crown is empowered to acquire land for Railways or Tramways, and it is deemed necessary to acquire such land, all the provisions of the said Act shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to the acquisition and vesting of such land : Provided, that land acquired for other than Road purposes shall not be a public highway as provided for by the said Act. Provisions of said Act applied to all land acquired for Railways or Tramways.
