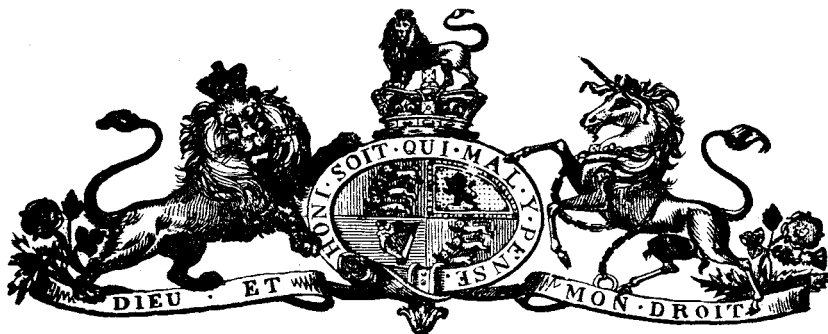

AN ACT to further amend "The *Latrobe* A.D. 1903.
Water Act, 1890." [23 December, 1903.] —

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The *Latrobe* Water PREAMBLE.
Act, 1890" (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), in the manner 54 Vict No. 52.
hereinafter appearing:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The *Latrobe* Water Short title.
Act Amendment Act, 1903."

2—(1) The words "Ten Pounds" are hereby expunged from the Amendment of
fifth line of Section Seventy-five of the said Act, and the words "Twelve Section 75 of 54
Pounds Ten Shillings" are hereby inserted in lieu thereof. Vict. No. 52.

(2.) The word "Five" is hereby inserted after the word "Twenty"
in the last line of the said Section Seventy-five of the said Act.
