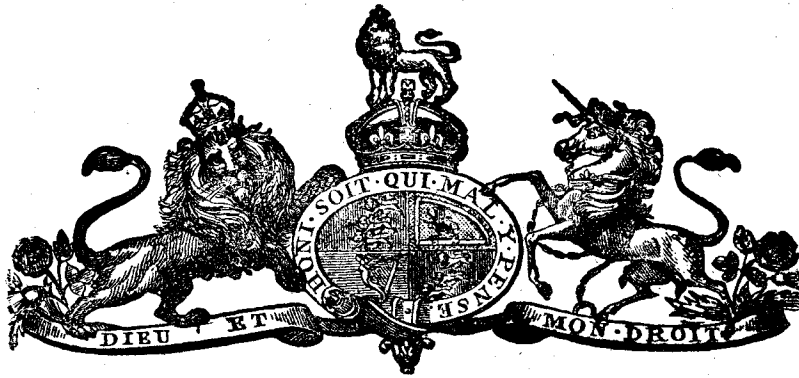

AN ACT to further amend "The Launceston Water and Light Act, 1895." A.D. 1919.

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The Launceston Water and Light Act, 1895:" PREAMBLE.
58 Vict. No. 31.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Launceston Water and Light Act, No. 7." Short title.

2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" means "The Launceston Water and Light Act, 1895." Interpretation.
