

# AN ACT to further amend "The Launceston 1919. Water and Light Act, 1895." [19 December, 1919.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The Launceston PREAMBLE.
Water and Light Act, 1895:"

58 Vict. No. 31.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Launceston Water and Light Short title. Act, No. 7."
  - 2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" means "The Laun-Interpretation. eston Water and Light Act, 1895."

Amendment of Section 62 of 58 Vict. No. 31. 3 In Section Sixty-two of the said Act—

The words "respective owners or" are hereby inserted before the word "occupiers" in the Third and Seventh lines: And the words 'owner or" are hereby inserted before the word "occupier" in the Fifteenth line.

Repeal of Section 1:9 of 58 Vict. No. 31.

4 Section One hundred and nineteen of the said Act is hereby repealed.

Acts to be read together.

5 This Act and the said Act and every other Act amending the said Act shall be read and construed together as one Act.
