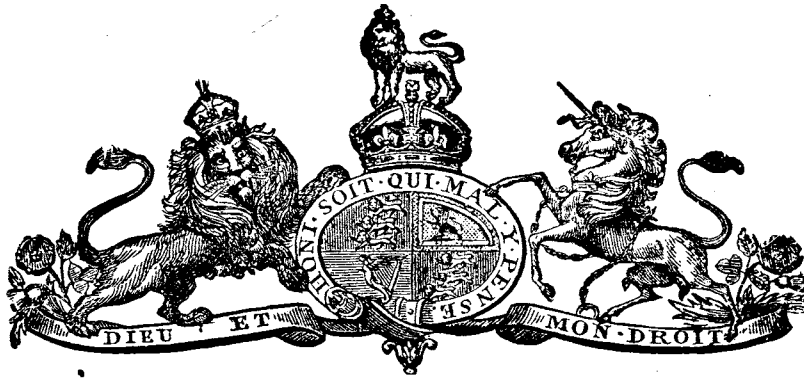

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of Section 15 of 59 Vic. No. 23.

AN ACT to amend "The Marriage Act, 1895," ^{A.D.} 1917.
and for other purposes. [8 February, 1917.] —

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Marriage Amendment Act, Short title, 1917."

2 Section Fifteen of "The Marriage Act, 1895," is hereby amended by inserting after the word "Act," occurring in the Third line thereof, the words "and may from time to time remove or cause to be removed from the List of Officiating Ministers the name of any minister of religion who in the opinion of the Governor is not a fit and proper person to celebrate marriages."
