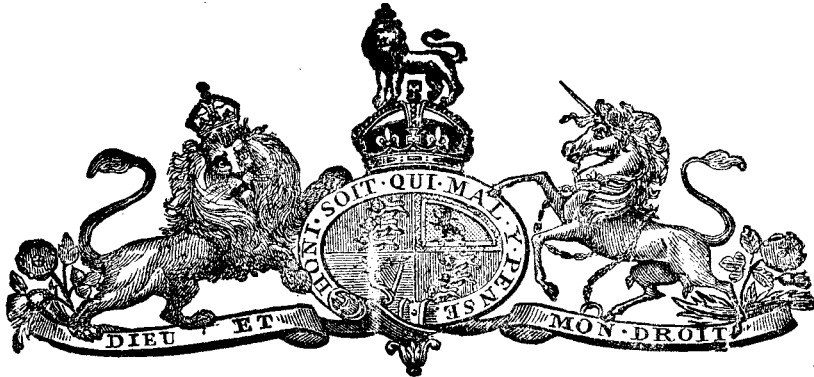

AN ACT to amend the Municipal Association Act, 1916. A.D. 1933.  
[8 December, 1933.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as “The Municipal Association Act, 1933.” Short title and commencement.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three.

**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after Section Eight the following new section:— Amendment of 7 Geo. V. No. 14.

“**8a** The Executive Committee of the Association in any calendar year may expend out of the funds of the Association any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of Twenty-five Pounds for any purposes whatever approved by the Committee.” New Section 8a Authorisation of certain expenditure by committee.
