AN ACT to amend "The Master and Servant A.D. 1882. Act, 1856." [9 October, 1882.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 In this Act the expression "the said Act" means "The Master Interpretation. and Servant Act, 1856.
- 2 Where the term or period of service of any servant shall be or Periodof warning become indefinite as to duration, such service shall, unless otherwise necessary to expressly agreed, be terminable by either party by a week's previous warning where the wages of such servant shall be payable weekly, by a fortnight's previous warning where the wages of such servant shall be payable fortnightly, and where such wages shall be payable at any longer period then by a month's previous warning.

- 3 Sections Six, Thirty-one, Thirty-two, and Thirty-three of the said Repeal. Act are hereby repealed.
- 4 The said Act as amended by this Act and this Act shall be read Acts to be read together. and construed together as one Act.
 - 5 This Act may be cited as "The Master and Servant Act, 1882." Short title.
