AN ACT to further amend The Marine Board A.D. 1881. Act. [8 November, 1881.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 Every Marine Board shall meet at such times and places as each Meetings of Board may from time to time appoint, and every such meeting, whether Boards. in Committee or otherwise, shall be open to the public.

2 This Act, and "The Marine Board Act," and every Act altering Acts to be read or amending the same, shall, save so far as the same may be altered or together. amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Marine Board Amendment Act, Short title, No. 5."
