

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Marine Board of Strahan Loan Short title. Amendment Act, 1903."
- 2 This Act shall come into operation on and after the First day of Commencement. January, One thousand nine hundred and four.
- 3 In this Act "the said Act" shall mean "The Marine Board of Interpretation. Strahan Loan Act, 1898." 62 Vict. No. 54.
  - 4 Sections Three and Six of the said Act are hereby repealed. Repeal.
- 5 There shall be payable and paid to the Treasurer of the State Interest payable interest at a rate not exceeding Three Pounds, per centum per annum upon Loan, 4d.]

#### Strahan Marine Board Loan Amendment.

upon the moneys advanced as a Loan under the provisions of the said Act, or any Amendment thereof, to the Marine Board of Strahan, after deducting the amount for the time being to the credit of the Sinking Fund established under the provisions of the said Act from the amount of the original loans. Such interest shall be chargeable upon the revenues of the said Marine Board, and shall be payable at such times and in such manner as the Governor may from time to time direct, and shall be paid into and form part of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.

Sinking Fund.

6 All moneys to the credit of the Sinking Fund established under the provisions of the said Act or any amendment thereof shall be placed in the books of the Treasury in the names of the said Treasurer and the Marine Board of Strahan, to an Account intituled as of such Loan, and may from time to time be applied to pay off any Loans which have been raised for the purposes of the said Act, or any amendment thereof.

Acts to read together.

7 This Act and the said Act and every Amendment thereof, save as altered or amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
