

AN ACT to further amend "The Mining A.D. 1895. Companies Act, 1884." [24 October, 1895.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Mining Companies Amendment Short title. Act, 1895.'
- 2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" shall mean "The Interpretation. 48 Vict. No. 15. Mining Companies Act, 1884."
- 3 The word "funds" in the second line of Section One hundred and Amendment of sixteen of the said Act is hereby repealed, and the word "assets" is inserted Sect. 116 of in lieu thereof, and the said Section shall hereafter be read and 48 Vict. No. 15. construed as if the word "assets" had always been inserted therein.
- 4 The Manager of any Company shall at the time of lodging with Amendment of the Secretary for Mines the notice of any Resolutions, as provided for Sect. 49 of by Section Forty-nine of the said Act, deposit with the Secretary for Mines a copy of the Gazette and newspapers in which notice of any such Resolution has been published as provided by the said Act.

Mining Companies Amendment.

A.D. 1895.

Liability of Directors of No Liability Company for certain wages. 5—(1.) The Directors of any Mining Company incorporated as a "No Liability" Company shall jointly and severally be personally liable for the payment of the wages or salary due to any person employed by such Company to any amount not exceeding the wages or salary earned by such person during the Two weeks immediately succeeding the last day for which payment of wages or salary has been made to such person.

(2.) No person shall be liable for the payment of any wages or salary under this Section unless he was a Director of the Company at the commencement of the period for which such wages or salary are due.

(3.) No person shall be relieved of any liability incurred as a Director of any Company in respect of any wages or salary due to any person by reason of such first-mentioned person having resigned or ceased to be a Director of the Company.

Operation of Act.

6 This Act shall come into operation and take effect from and after the First day of *November*, One thousand eight hundred and ninety-five.

Acts to be read together.

7 This Act and the said Act, and every Act amending the same, save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
