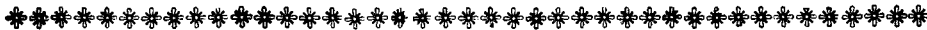

AN ACT to amend "The *Mount Cameron* Water-race Act, 1887." [16 October, 1888.] A.D. 1888.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The *Mount Cameron* Water-race Act, 1887 :"  
PREAMBLE.  
51 Vict. No. 23.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 In this Act "the said Act" means "The *Mount Cameron* Water-race Act, 1887," and "the said Board" means "The *Mount Cameron* Water-race Board." Interpretation.

2—(1.) If any person appointed by the Governor in Council under the provisions of the said Act or this Act as a Member of the said Board shall die, resign, or be absent without leave of the said Board from Three consecutive Meetings thereof, such person shall thereupon cease to be a Member of the said Board ; and it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to appoint another person to be a Member of the said Board in the place of any person ceasing to be a Member of the said Board from any of the causes aforesaid. Extraordinary vacancies in the Board.

(2.) Any person appointed by the Governor in Council to fill any such vacancy shall retain his office so long only as the vacating Member would have retained the same if no vacancy had occurred.

(3.) Until any such vacancy shall be filled in manner aforesaid, it shall be lawful for the surviving or continuing Members of the said Board to act in all respects as if no such vacancy had occurred.

**3** No Regulation shall be made under the provisions of the said Act permitting water to be supplied under the said Act free of charge; and any Regulation heretofore made under the said Act permitting water to be supplied free of charge is hereby declared to be null and void.

Acts to be read  
together.

**4** This Act and the said Act, save as amended or altered by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act.

Short title.

**5** This Act may be cited for all purposes as “The *Mount Cameron Water-race Amendment Act, 1888.*”
