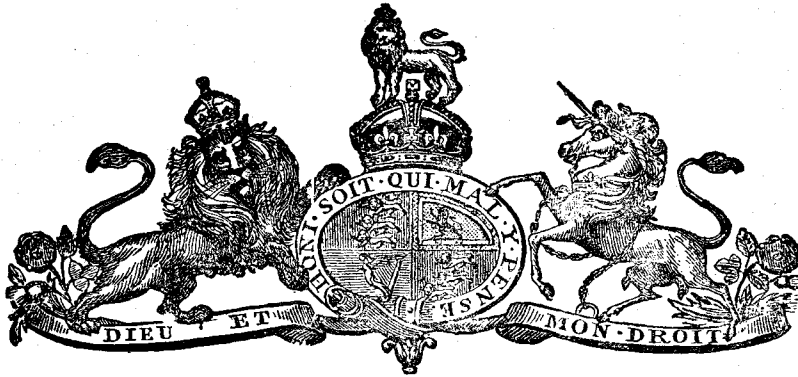

AN ACT to further amend “The *Mount Cameron Water-race Act, 1887.*”
[25 October, 1906.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The *Mount Cameron Water-race Amendment Act, 1906,*” and shall be read and incorporated with “The *Mount Cameron Water-race Act, 1887,*” and the Acts amending the same.

2 In this Act “the said Act” means “The *Mount Cameron Water-race Act, 1887,*” and “the Board” means the *Mount Cameron Water-race Board.*

3—(1.) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Section Six of the said Act, it shall be lawful for the Board to retain the whole of the moneys received during the period commencing the First day of *July*, One thousand nine hundred and five, and ending the Thirtieth day of *June*, One thousand nine hundred and eight (both dates inclusive), from the sale of water supplied by means of or from the water-race under the control of the Board, without making any payment thereout for the purposes of “The Public Debts Sinking Fund Act, 1881.”

(2.) The Board may from time to time use and apply the whole or any part of the said moneys so received and retained as aforesaid as they think fit in or towards maintaining, managing, repairing, or improving the said water-race and the works connected therewith.
