

AN ACT to further amend "The Mount 1906. Cameron Water-race Act, 1887."

[25 October, 1906.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

4d.

1 This Act may be cited as "The Mount Cameron Water-race Short title. Amendment Act, 1906," and shall be read and incorporated with 51 Vict. No. 28. "The Mount Cameron Water-race Act, 1887," and the Acts amending the same.

2 In this Act "the said Act" means "The Mount Cameron Waterrace Act, 1887," and "the Board" means the Mount Cameron Waterrace Board.

## Mount Cameron Water-race.

A.D. 1906.

Power to Board to apply all moneys received from 1 July, 1905, to 30 June, 1908, for certain purposes, notwithstanding Section Six of 51 Viet. No. 28.

3—(1.) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Section Six of the said Act, it shall be lawful for the Board to retain the whole of the moneys received during the period commencing the First day of July, One thousand nine hundred and five, and ending the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and eight (both dates inclusive), from the sale of water supplied by means of or from the water-race under the control of the Board, without making any payment thereout for the purposes of "The Public Debts Sinking Fund Act, 1881."

(2.) The Board may from time to time use and apply the whole or any part of the said moneys so received and retained as aforesaid as they think fit in or towards maintaining, managing, repairing, or improving the said water-race and the works connected therewith.
