

## AN ACT to amend "The Military Discipline A.D. 1883. Act, 1878." [29 October, 1883.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 In this Act—
"The said Act" means "The Military Discipline Act, 1878."

- 2 In the said Act the word "Force" used therein shall include the Construction of Engineer Corps engaged under this Act; and whenever in the said Act terms. "The Mutiny Act" is mentioned it shall be taken to mean the Act 42 & 43 Vict. of the Imperial Parliament to amend the Law relating to the Discipline c. 33. and Regulation of the Army.
- 3 The Governor may engage, upon the terms and conditions Engineer Corps contained in the said Act, the services of such a number of persons, not may be engaged. exceeding Seventy-five, to serve in the said Engineer Corps, as Parliament shall from time to time authorise and provide for.
- 4 The provisions contained in Section Twenty of the said Act shall Provisions not to not apply to any member of the said Engineer Corps engaged under apply to Engineer this Act.
- 5 The said Act, as amended by this Act, and this Act, shall be read Acts to be read and construed together as one Act.
  - 6 This Act may be cited as "The Military Discipline Act, 1883." Short title.
