AN ACT to provide for the Maintenance of A.D. 1904. certain Main Roads. [11 November, 1904.]

W HEREAS "The Main Roads Maintenance Act, 1903," failed to PREAMBLE. provide for the maintenance of the Main Roads therein referred to, for more than the period of the Six months ending the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and four, in consequence of the Appropriation out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, under the Act of Parliament 3 Edwardi VII., No. 41, being for the said period of Six months only, instead of, as erroneously stated in the former Act, for

the year one thousand nine hundred and four:

And whereas the trustees of some of the Road Districts named in the Eighth column of the Schedule to the first-mentioned Act did, pursuant to Sub-section (3.) of Section Three of that Act, contribute the full amount of the sums set opposite to their names in the Seventh column of the said Schedule; and it is necessary that such part of any contribution so made by the Trustees of a Road District as is in excess of the sum actually payable by the Trustees of such Road District in respect of the said period of Six months shall be credited to the Trustees of that Road District in the manner provided by the following enactment:

And whereas Parliament has specially appropriated out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the year ending the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and five the amount of Seven thousand

five hundred Pounds as subsidies for Main Roads:

And whereas it is desirable to declare the amount of the sum per mile which is to be expended upon certain Main Roads set forth in the Schedule to the following enactment, and also the amount which is to be contributed towards certain Main Roads by the Trustees of the several Road Districts as set forth in that Schedule, and also to declare what portion of such sum of Seven thousand five hundred Pounds is to be expended upon Bridges, Culverts, and Contingencies:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and

House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as "The Main Roads Maintenance Act, 1904."

Interpretation.

2 In this Act, the expression "the Minister" shall mean the Minister of Lands and Works of Tasmania for the time being.

Amendment of

- 3—(1.) This Act shall in respect of the period of Six months 3 Ed.VII. No. 10. ending the Thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and four, take the place of the provisions for the maintenance of Main Roads intended and expressed to be made by "The Main Roads Maintenance Act, 1903," so far as relates to the said period of Six
 - (2.) Where the Trustees of any Road District named in the Eighth column of the Schedule to this Act have, before the commencement of this Act, made a contribution under "The Main Roads Maintenance Act, 1903," towards the maintenance of a Main Road set opposite their names in the First column of the Schedule to the last-mentioned Act, in excess of One-half of the sum set opposite their names in the Seventh column of the last-mentioned Schedule, the amount so paid by them in excess shall be credited to them as a payment of, or on account of, the contribution payable by them under Sub-section (3.) of Section Four of this Act towards the maintenance of the same Main Road.

- 4—(1.) The Roads set forth in the first column of the Schedule shall be and they are hereby declared to be Main Roads of Tasmania for the purposes of "The Roads Act, 1884," and shall be maintained in each District respectively, in accordance with the provisions of Part II. of the said Act, at an average cost per mile for the year ending the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and five not exceeding that specified in the Fourth column of the Schedule: Provided that the sums set forth in the said Schedule, other than the average cost per mile of such Roads, shall be appropriated to and for the purposes therein specified.
- (2.) The cost of maintenance of the said Main Roads shall be contributed partly out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in the proportion and in the amounts set forth in the Sixth column of the

Schedule.

(3.) The Trustees of the Road Districts named in the Eighth A.D. 1904. column of the Schedule shall contribute towards the maintenance of the Main Roads set opposite to their respective names in the First column of the Schedule the respective sums set opposite to their names in the Seventh column of the Schedule.

(4.) Any contribution payable by the Trustees of a Road District in respect of a Main Road may be paid by two equal instalments, and if so paid, the contribution payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund in respect of that Main Road shall in like manner be paid by two equal instalments.

5 All contributions towards the maintenance of Main Roads When contribudirected to be made by the Trustees of the Road Districts named as tions to be paid. aforesaid, shall be paid to the Minister before the Thirty-first day of January, One thousand nine hundred and five.

6 It shall be lawful for the Minister for the purpose of obtaining Minister may payments of such contributions to issue his precept to the Trustees of issue precept. the Road Districts named as aforesaid, requiring the Trustees to pay, within a time limited by the precept, the amount set opposite to their names in the Seventh column of the Schedule hereto.

7 The Trustees of the Road Districts named as aforesaid shall Trustees to comply with the requisitions of such precept, by paying the contri- comply with bution required out of any moneys at the disposal of the Trustees.

8 If the amount required by any precept of the Minister, or any Remedy for nonpart thereof, to be paid by the Trustees of any Road District is not payment of paid in the manner directed by the precept, and within the time therein specified for that purpose, the Minister may, by writing under his hand, appoint, at such salary as he thinks fit, a Receiver of the rates of such Road District, and may from time to time remove such Receiver.

Any Receiver appointed under this Section shall be entitled to receive all rates payable to such Trustees, and to make and levy rates for the purpose of paying the amounts due under such precept together with all costs and expenses (including the amount of his salary), and for the purposes aforesaid the Receiver shall be deemed to be the Trustees, and may exercise all their powers. Any such Receiver shall continue to act until payment has been made to the Minister of the amount in default, together with all costs and expenses as aforesaid.

9 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in "The Minister may Roads Act, 1884," it shall, be lawful for the Governor, if he shall think cause money fit, to authorise the Minister to cause to be expended the whole or any part of the money appropriated by this Act in the maintenance of the Main Road for which such money is appropriated.

Power for Ulverstone Town Board to pay off part of Bank overdraft for 1903, incurred by Ulverstone Main Road Board. **10** It shall be lawful for the Board of the Town of *Ulverstone* to expend out of the funds at the disposal of such Board towards payment of the Bank overdraft incurred by the Board of Main Roads for the District of *Ulverstone* during the year One thousand nine hundred and three and Bank interest chargeable thereou up to the date of such payment, a sum not exceeding One-half of such overdraft and interest.
