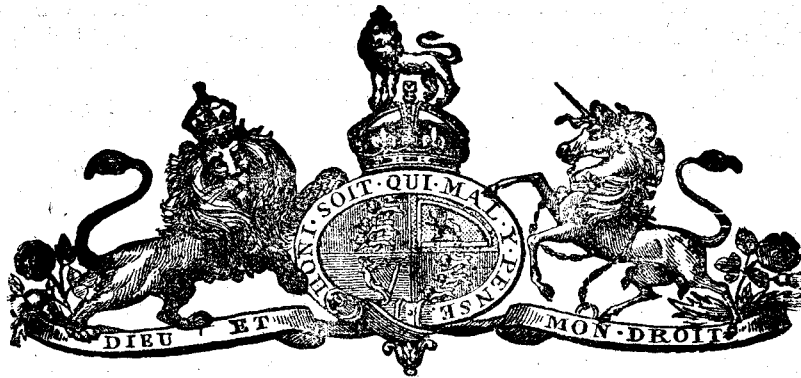

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title and incorporation with 9 Geo. V. No. 62.

AN ACT to appropriate a certain Sum arising from the Consolidated Revenue in aid of "The Mining Trust Fund Act, 1918," and for other purposes. [20 December, 1920.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Mining Trust Fund Act, 1920," and shall be incorporated with "The Mining Trust Fund Act, 1918" (hereinafter called the Principal Act), and any amendment thereof.

2—(1) There shall and may be appropriated and issued out of the Consolidated Revenue, and applied in the manner provided by the Principal Act as amended by this Act, the further sum of One thousand Pounds, for the purposes expressed in the Principal Act as amended by this Act.

(2) The said sum shall be paid into and credited by the Treasurer to the Mining Trust Fund, 1918-19, established under the Principal Act, and shall form part of such fund.

3 The Second Schedule to the Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following paragraphs :—

“7. To provide for advances towards the re-establishment and operation of an ore-concentrating mill at Zeehan.

“8. To provide for the construction, maintenance, and working of One or more State boring-plants.”
