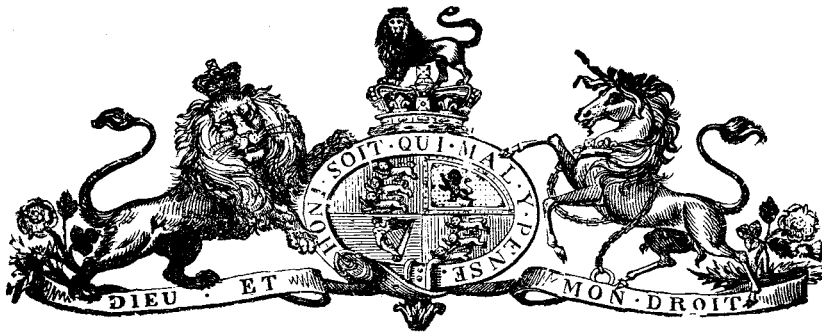

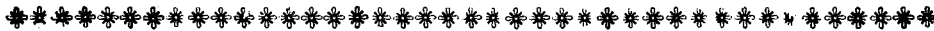

AN ACT to Substitute a Geographical A.D. 1903.
Boundary for the present division of this
State into Northern and Southern Electoral
Districts for the purposes of certain Acts,
and for other purposes. [28 November, 1903.]

WHEREAS in certain Acts of the Parliament of this State, and in PREAMBLE.
certain Rules of Court, Regulations, and By-laws, reference is made to
“the Northern Electoral Districts” and “the Southern Electoral
Districts” and to “the Northern and Southern Districts”: And
whereas there is now no distinction between the Northern and the
Southern Electoral Districts: And whereas it is desirable to substitute
other provisions for any division of this State into Northern and
Southern Electoral Districts:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

2 The following words in Section Three of "The Tasmanian Law Societies Act, 1887," are hereby repealed, that is to say, "The Northern District shall comprise the Legislative Council Districts of *Russell, Mersey, Morven, Tamar, Westmorland, North Esk, South Esk*, and *Launceston*, and the Southern District shall comprise the Legislative Council Districts of *Macquorie, Cambridge, Pembroke, Derwent, Buckingham, Huon*, and *Hobart*, as mentioned respectively in 'The Electoral Act, No. 7,' and in the Act of 50 *Victoria*, No. 3."

"Northern Electoral Districts," or "Northern District," deemed to refer to certain Counties.

3—(1.) Where in any Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania*, or in any Rules of Court, Regulations, or By-laws, any reference is made to "the Northern Electoral Districts," or to "the Northern District," the same shall, for the purposes of such Act, Rules, Regulations, or By-laws, be deemed to be a reference to all that portion of the State of *Tasmania* comprised in the Counties of *Wellington, Russell, Lincoln, Devon, Westmorland, Dorset, Cornwall, Somerset*, and *Flinders*, and any Dependency of the said State not included in any County, and situate north of the Forty-second parallel of south latitude.

"Southern Electoral Districts," or "Southern District," deemed to refer to certain Counties.

(2.) Where in any Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania*, or in any Rules of Court, Regulations, or By-laws, any reference is made to "the Southern Electoral Districts," or to "the Southern District," the same shall, for the purposes of such Act, Rules, Regulations, or By-laws, be deemed to be a reference to all that portion of the State of *Tasmania* comprised in the Counties of *Montagu, Franklin, Montgomery, Arthur, Kent, Buckingham, Monmouth, Pembroke, Glamorgan*, and *Cumberland*, and any Dependency of the said State not included in any County, and situate south of the Forty-second parallel of south latitude.
