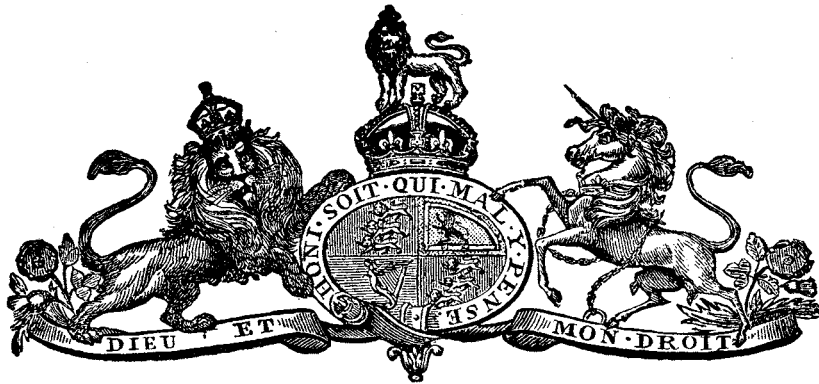

against the Person Act, 1885."

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Offences against the Person Act, 1912," and shall be incorporated and read as one with "The Offences against the Person Act, 1885," in this Act referred to as "the said Act."

2 Section Six of the said Act is hereby amended by omitting from the last proviso thereof the words "Fifteen days," and inserting in lieu thereof the words "Three months."
