

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title.

2. Annual pension to Emily Beatrice O'Keefe.

3. Treasurer to pay pension upon Governor's warrant.

AN ACT to provide for the Payment of a 1926. Pension to Emily Beatrice O'Keefe, widow of Michael Ignatius O'Keefe, late Speaker of the House of Assembly.

[21 *December*, 1926.]

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The O'Keefe Pension Act, 1926."

Short title.

2 There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue to Emily Beatrice O'Keefe, widow of Michael Ignatius O'Keefe, late Emily Beatrice Speaker of the House of Assembly, an annual pension, as follows:-

Annual pension to O'Keefe.

1. From the second day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, and until the said Emily Beatrice O'Keefe attains the age of sixty years, or sooner re-marries or dies, pension at the rate of One hundred and four Pounds per annum and,

O'Keefe Pension.

A.D. 1926.

II. If the said Emily Beatrice O'Keefe shall attain the age of sixty years without having re-married, from and after her attaining such age and until her decease, pension at the rate of Thirty-two Pounds Ten Shillings per annum—and such pension shall be payable monthly, as from the said second day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six.

Treasurer to pay pension upon Governor's warrant. 3 The Governor shall, from time to time, issue his warrant to the Treasurer for the payment of the pension payable under this Act, and the same shall thereupon be paid by the Treasurer to the said *Emily Beatrice O'Keefe*, or to such other person as she shall, by writing under her hand, appoint to receive the same.
