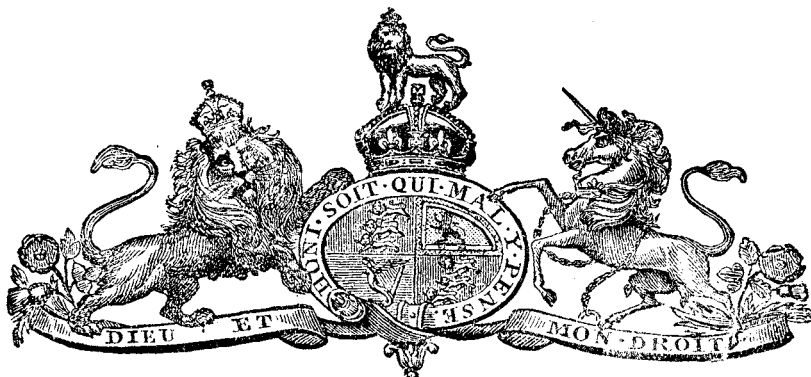

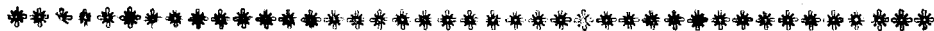

AN ACT to amend the Oatlands Lighting Act, 1926. [17 September, 1928.]

WHEREAS the Warden, councillors and electors of the Municipality of Oatlands are desirous of making provision for the lighting of further part of the said Municipality by electricity in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act, 1924 :

And whereas it is desirable to authorise the Council of the said Municipality to borrow a further sum of One thousand eight hundred Pounds for the purposes aforesaid :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Title and incorporation with 6 Ed. VII. No. 31.

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Oatlands Lighting Act, 1928,” and shall be read as one and incorporated with the Local Government Act, 1906.

Principal Act. 17 Geo. V. No. 54.

**2** The Oatlands Lighting Act, 1926, is herein called “the Principal Act.”

Power to borrow £1800 under 45 Vict. No. 16 and 17 Geo. V. No. 54.

**3** It shall be lawful for the Council, on behalf of the Corporation, in addition to any moneys already borrowed under the Principal Act, to raise by way of loan, under the provisions of the Local Bodies Loans Act as modified by the Principal Act, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of One thousand eight hundred Pounds for the purposes mentioned in the Preamble to this Act and of defraying the costs of and incidental to the preparation and passing of this Act.
