## AN ACT to fix the Salaries of certain 1927. Officers of Parliament. [14 October, 1927.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Officers of Parliament Salaries Short title and Act, 1927," and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the commencement. first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven.

2 The Officers of Parliament Salaries Act, 1919, is hereby repealed. Repeal.

### Officers of Parliament Salaries.

A.D. 1927.

Salaries payable to officers mentioned in schedule. 3—(1) From and after the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, there shall be paid and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue, as the yearly salaries of the respective persons holding the offices mentioned in the schedule to this Act, the respective sums set opposite the names of such offices in the said schedule.

(2) The salary payable to any person under this Act shall be in addition to any other allowance to which he may be entitled as a

Member of Parliament.

Continuance of salaries after dissolution, &c., and until general election. 4 When a person holding the office of Speaker or Chairman of Committees of the House of Assembly ceases to be a member of that House by reason of its dissolution or expiring by effluxion of time, he shall, notwithstanding such cessation of membership, continue to be entitled to payment of the salary attached to such office until the day fixed for the taking of the poll at the general election next following such dissolution or expiry.
