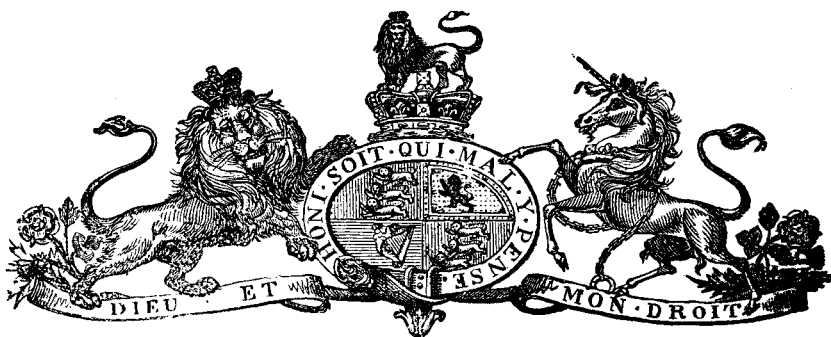

AN ACT to further amend *The Police Act*, A.D. 1891.
1865 [23 December, 1891.] —

WHEREAS, under and for the purposes of *The Property Valuation Act*, the term "District" is defined to mean a "Police District :"
PREAMBLE.

And whereas certain Police Districts are of so great an area that persons living in parts of the same suffer inconvenience and loss by reason thereof, inasmuch as the principal Police Offices or places of holding Petty Sessions in such Districts are far distant from the situation of many of the properties comprised in the Valuation Rolls for such Districts, and such persons are put to loss of time and trouble in attending the annual revision of such Rolls, and in appealing to the Courts of Appeal against such Valuation Rolls :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Fifth Section of *The Police Act*, 1865, it shall be lawful for the Governor, by Proclamation published in the *Gazette*, to appoint any portion or portions of any Municipal District as he sees fit to be a Police District or Districts; and may assign to such District or Districts such names as he sees fit. **Governor may appoint part of Municipal District to be a Police District, &c.**

2 The said Act and every Act altering or amending the same, and this Act, shall, save as altered or amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act. **Acts to be read together.**

3 This Act may be cited as "The Police Act Amendment Act, Short title. 1891."
