

AN ACT to provide for the Construction of certain Public Works. [11 October, 1867.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer to cause to be con-Colonial Treasurer structed and completed the several Works mentioned in the Schedule, at to cause Works to a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amount therein set be constructed. opposite such Work.

- 2 The cost of such Works shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be Defrayment of raised by loan for the purpose under the authority of "The Public cost of Works. Buildings Loans Act, 1867."
 - 3 This Act may be cited as "The Public Buildings Act, 1867." Short title.
