AN ACT to provide for the Construction of certain Public Works. [18 October, 1870.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to cause to Minister of Lands be constructed and completed the several Works mentioned in the Schedule, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amount be constructed. therein set opposite such Work.

2 The cost of such Works shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be Defrayment of raised by loan for the purpose under the authority of "The Public cost of Works. Buildings Loans Act, 1870."

3 This Act may be cited as "The Public Buildings Act, 1870."
