

AN ACT to provide for the Erection and A.D. 1885. Construction of certain Public Buildings. [5 December, 1885.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to cause Minister of Lands the several Works mentioned in the Schedule to be erected, constructed, to cause Works to and completed, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the be constructed. amount therein set opposite such Work.

- 2 The cost of such Works shall be defrayed out of the moneys Defrayment of provided by Parliament for that purpose.
- 3 The Governor in Council may, upon the recommendation of the Purchase, &c. of Minister, out of the moneys hereby appropriated, authorise the Minister land. to purchase, acquire, and take any land, with or without buildings thereon, which he deems suitable for the purposes of any Work by this Act authorised.

4 This Act may be cited as "The Public Buildings Erection Act, Short title. 1885."
