

## AN ACT to authorise the raising of Money for the Construction of certain Public Works. [11 October, 1867.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to raise, by Loans secured on the General PREAMBLE. Revenue, Funds for the construction of certain Public Works: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-
