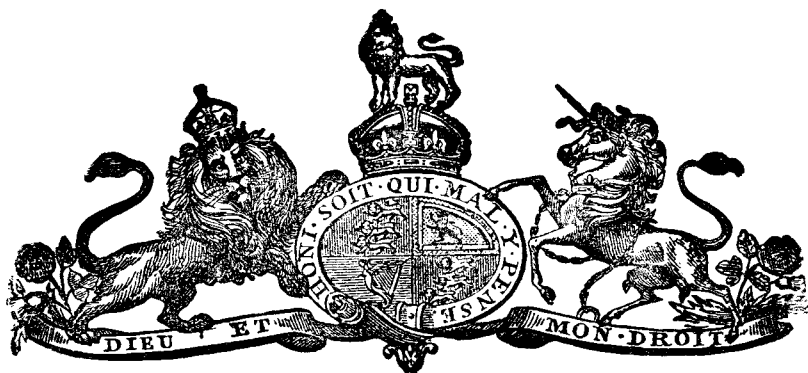

AN ACT to amend the Plant Diseases Act, 1930. [19 October, 1931.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Plant Diseases Act, 1931.”

2 The Plant Diseases Act, 1930, is hereby amended by inserting after Section Three the following new Section **3a**:—

“**3a** The importation of plants into this State shall be subject to such restrictions and conditions as are prescribed for preventing the introduction of disease.”
