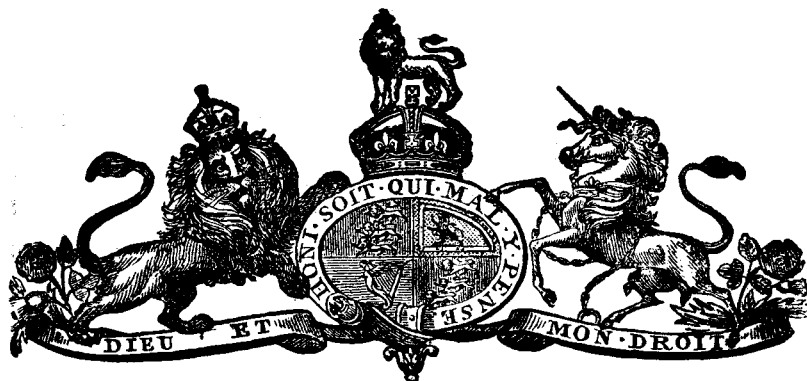

1. Short title and incorporation with 9 Ed. VII. No. 5.
2. Governor may exempt area from provisions as to spraying.  
Governor may cancel any exemption.



AN ACT to amend "The Potato Diseases Act, 1909." A.D. 1909  
[30 December, 1909.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The Potato Diseases Amendment Act, 1909," and shall be incorporated and read as one with "The Potato Diseases Act, 1909," in this Act referred to as the Principal Act. Short title and incorporation with 9 Ed. VII. No. 5.

**2**—(1.) The Governor may, by proclamation, from time to time exempt any area he may define from the operation of the provisions of the Principal Act relating to spraying; and such area shall, upon the Governor may exempt area from provisions as to spraying.

publication of the proclamation in the *Gazette*, be exempted accordingly for the period and upon the conditions stated in the proclamation.

(2.) The Governor may, by proclamation, cancel any such exemption in respect of any area; and upon the publication of such proclamation in the *Gazette*, the said provisions of the Principal Act relating to spraying shall again be operative within the area.
