## AN ACT to amend the Law relating to A.D. 1889. Powers of Attorney. [5 December, 1889.]

W HEREAS the Seventh Section of the Act, intituled "An Act to PREAMBLE. make valid acts done under Powers of Attorney in certain Cases," was 24 Vict. No. 3. repealed by "The Conveyancing and Law of Property Act, 1884": 47 Vict. No. 16

And whereas it is expedient to revive the said Section of the Act firstly hereinbefore mentioned :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :----

1 This Act may be cited as "The Powers of Attorney Act, 1889." Short title.

2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" means the Act 24 Interpretation. Victoria, No. 3, intituled "An Act to make valid acts done under Powers of Attorney in certain Cases."

3 The Seventh Section of the said Act is hereby revived, and the Sect. 7 of 24 Vict. said Act shall be hereafter read and construed as if the said Section No. 3 revived. had never been repealed.

4 Part III. of the First Schedule to "The Conveyancing and Law Repeal of part of Presents Act, 1984 "is hereby expunded therefrom 47 Vict. No. 19. of Property Act, 1884," is hereby expunged therefrom.
