AN ACT to amend "The Parliamentary A.D. 1904. Privilege Act, 1898." [11 November, 1904.]

W HEREAS it is desirable to amend "The Parliamentary PREAMBLE. Privilege Act, 1898:" 62 Vict. No. 30.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The authority of the President or Speaker mentioned in Section Authority of Five of the said Act, shall, anything contained in the Audit Act to President or the contrary notwithstanding, be deemed to have been, and shall be speaker to be sufficient to enable the Auditor Consults great a full and complete sufficient to enable the Auditor-General to grant a full and complete discharge in respect of any expenditure so authorised: Provided that any such expenditure may be disallowed by either House of Parliament.

- 2 This Act, and "The Parliamentary Privilege Act," and "The Acts to be read Parliamentary Privilege Act Amendment Act, 1885," and "The together. Parliamentary Privilege Act, 1898," shall be read and construed together as one Act.
- 3 This Act may be cited as "The Parliamentary Privilege Act, Short title. 1904."
