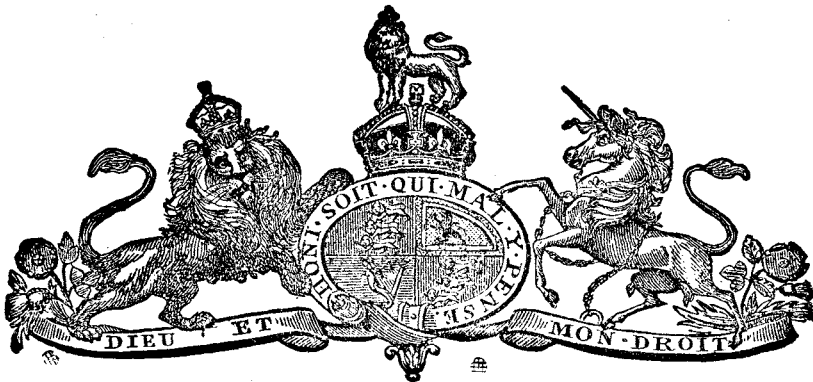

AN ACT to amend "The Public Service Act, 1923." A.D. 1923.
[11 July, 1923.] —

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1**—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Public Service Act (No. 2), 1923." Short title.
- (2) "The Public Service Act, 1923," is herein called the Principal Act. Principal Act.

2 The time for making the First determination under Section Twenty of the Principal Act is hereby extended to the Thirty-first day of August, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, and such determination shall have effect, subject as hereinafter provided, as from the First day of July, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three.

3 Notwithstanding anything contained in Section Twenty of the Principal Act salaries of officers shall, up to the time of the First bi-monthly payment of salaries occurring after the passing of an Appropriation Act for the financial year ending on the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, be payable at the rates fixed by the Minister as in the Principal Act provided in respect of the period from the First day of April, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, to the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three.

Provided, however, that within One month after the passing of such Appropriation Act, as aforesaid, there shall be paid to every officer whose salary, as fixed by the First determination of the Board, is in excess of the salary which was last payable to him under the immediately preceding provision of this section, the amount of such excess as from the First day of July, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, up to the time of the First payment of salary to such officer after the passing of such Appropriation Act as aforesaid.

4 Section Fifty-five of the Principal Act is hereby amended as from the commencement of that Act, as follows:—

“As to Subsection (2), by deleting the words ‘extra services’ in the Second line thereof, and substituting the word ‘overtime’ therefor:

II. As to Subsection (3), by deleting the words ‘extra services’ in the First line thereof, and substituting the word ‘overtime’ therefor.”
