

AN ACT to amend "The Public Schools Erection Act, 1880." [8 November, 1881.] "The Public Schools A.D. 1881.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 Section Two of "The Public Schools Erection Act, 1880," is Repeal Sect. 2 of hereby repealed, and the enactment hereinafter contained is hereby 44 Vict. No. 6. substituted for the provisions contained in the said Section.
- 2 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, upon the recom- Governor in mendation of the Board, to cause School Houses to be erected and built Council may in such localities as the Board may from time to time determine, at a cause School House not exceeding in respect of any School House the sum of Five erected. hundred Pounds.

When the estimated cost of any School House shall exceed the sum of Five hundred Pounds, the erection of such School House shall not be proceeded with unless Parliament shall approve of the same, and the same shall when erected vest in the Board.

- 3 "The Public Schools Erection Act, 1880," as amended by this Acts to be read Act, and this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act.
- 4 This Act may be cited as "The Public Schools Erection Amendment Short title. Act, 1881."
