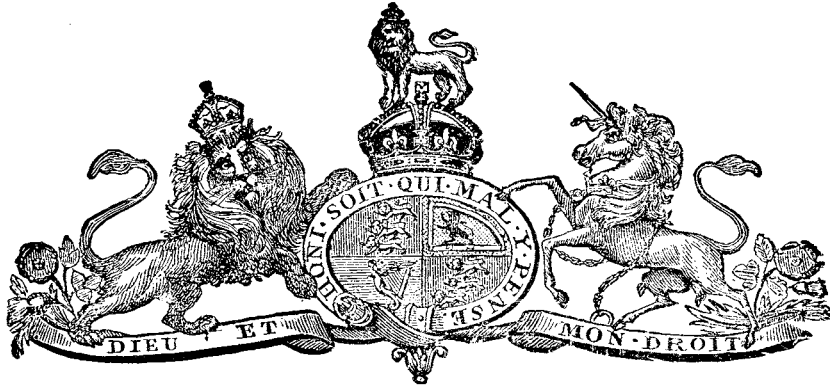

AN ACT to amend the Public Trust Office Act, 1930. A.D. 1933.
[10 January, 1934.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Public Trust Office Act, 1933.” Short title.

No. 61.**2** The Public Trust Office Act, 1930, is hereby amended—

I. By inserting after Subsection (3) of Section Sixty-five thereof the following new Subsection (3A):—

“(3A) Where the Public Trustee is administering any estate, and it appears that there are no persons entitled to share in the distribution of the estate as hereinbefore provided, the Public Trustee may apply to the Court for directions as to the manner in which any person or persons amongst whom such estate or part thereof shall be distributed. On such application the Court may order advertisements to issue as hereinbefore provided, and, upon proof by affidavit of compliance therewith, the Court may, in its absolute discretion, make such further order authorising the Public Trustee to distribute such estate or part thereof amongst such persons as the Court shall think fit, having regard to all the circumstances of the estate and to the just claim of any such person thereto, notwithstanding that any such person is not in law entitled to share in the distribution of the estate.”:

II. By deleting the words “Such further order” in the first line of Subsection (4) of Section Sixty-five thereof and inserting in their stead the words “Any such order as aforesaid.”.
