AN ACT to provide for the Construction of certain Public Works. [21 December, 1871.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to cause to be constructed and completed the several Works mentioned in the Schedule, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amount therein set opposite such Work.

Minister of Lands to cause Works to be constructed.

2 Out of the sum of £4975 15s. 10d. for "Port Cygnet Tramway," appropriated by *The Public Works Act, 1865*, and out of the sum of £3500, "for completion of the Road from *Port Esperance* to *Southport*," and out of the sum of £2000 "for Road or Track from *Franklin* following a proposed line of Tramroad," which sums of £3500 and £2000 are severally appropriated by the Act of the 31st *Victoria*, No. 23, there may be applied in the construction and completion of the Works mentioned in the Schedule the sums set opposite the same respectively, anything in the said Acts to the contrary notwithstanding.

Appropriation of moneys to Works in Schedule.

The sum of £2500 appropriated by the Act of the 33rd *Victoria*, No. 16, to the works named in the Schedule to that Act may be applied for defraying the expenditure incurred in constructing a Road and Bridges from the Township of *Upway* to the Gold Fields at *Waterhouse*, including a Bridge over the *Great Forester River* and the Road through *Stephenson's Marsh*; and a Road from the Landing-place at the *Tomahawk* to the Gold Fields at *Waterhouse*; and also a Track from

Tucker's Corner of the Gold Fields at Waterbury, and towards completing the construction of the same, anything in the said Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

Short Title.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Act, 1871."
