AN ACT to provide for the Construction and A.D. 1887. Execution of certain Public Works. [20 December, 1887.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines— Interpretation.
 - "The Minister" means the Minister of Lands and Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his orders.
- 2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, Works to be concompleted, improved, or executed, the several Works mentioned in the structed. Schedule, at a cost for each separate Work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said Schedule respectively.
- 3 The cost of the several Works specified in the First Part of the Defrayment of Schedule shall be defrayed out of the moneys to be provided by cost of Works. Parliament for that purpose.
- 4 The cost of the several Works specified in the Second Part of the Cost of certain Schedule shall be defrayed out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund; Works to be and the Treasurer of the Colony, upon the Governor's Warrant, may issue and pay out of the said Fund in the year commencing on the

Public Works Construction.

A.D. 1887.

First day of July, 1887, and ending on the Thirtieth day of June, 1888, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money in the Second Part of the Schedule specified.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 to be applicable.

5 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," shall extend and apply to the several Works mentioned in the Schedule to this Act, as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Appropriation of part of moneys voted by 50 Vict. No. 23.

6 Out of the sum of Five hundred Pounds appropriated by "The Public Works Construction Act, 1886," for—

Improvements to Lower Road near Cornelian Bay Cemetery,

a sum not exceeding Sixty Pounds shall and may be applied towards and for the erection of Gatekeeper's Cottage at Railway Crossing on said Road.

7 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Construction Act, 1887."
