AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Public Works. [18 March, 1924]

1**924.**

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Execution Act Short title. (No. 1), 1924."
- 2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines, "the Interpretation, Minister" means the Minister for Lands and Works for the time being.

A.D. 1924.

Minister may cause works to be constructed.

3 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed, the works specified in this Act, at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amounts set forth in this Act.

Appropriation for items in Schedule

4 The cost of the several works specified in the Schedule to this Act, shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

Money not required for work may be expended by Minister on other works. 5 If the Minister at any time reports to the Governor that the whole or any portion of the money voted by this Act or any previous Act providing for the execution of public works is not required to be expended upon the work or item for which such money is voted, it shall be lawful for the Minister to expend such balance, provided it does not exceed Fifty Pounds, upon such other work or works previously authorised by Parliament, as he may think fit: Provided that such lastmentioned work is situated in the same city or municipality, as the case may be, as the work for which such money was originally voted.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 and 45 Vict. No. 31 to be applicable. 6 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," and "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881," shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in this Act as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Land required may be acquired under 1 Geo. V. No. 11, at option of Minister. 7 Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, or any Act incorporated therewith, any land required for the purpose of any public work specified in this Act, may at the option of the Minister be purchased, acquired, or taken under "The Lands Resumption Act, 1910," and in the event of such option being so exercised the provisions of that Act shall accordingly apply, and be deemed to be incorporated with this Act, in lieu of the provisions of "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," and "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881."

8 It shall be lawful for the Minister to expend—

In or towards the construction, execution, improvement, or completion of the road near Turvey's towards Colebrook to top of Brandy Bottom Hill, the sum of One hundred Pounds appropriated for Item Five hundred and seventy-two (Craigburn Road, Grieve's and Thallin's) of the Schedule to "The Public Works Execution Act (No. 1), 1923":
