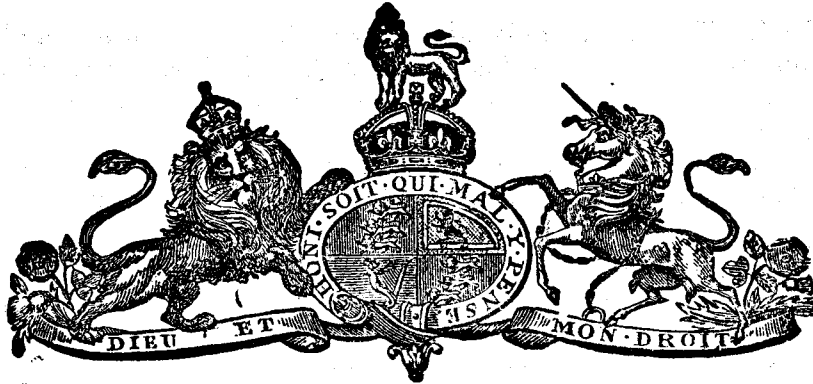

AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Public Works. [29 October, 1930.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Public Works Execution Act, Short title. 1930.”

2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be undertaken, executed, carried out, and completed the works specified in the schedule to this Act at a cost not exceeding in respect of any item so specified the sum set forth in the said schedule in respect thereof.

Minister may cause works in schedule to be carried out.

Public Works Execution.

A.D. 1930.

Cost of works to be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by the Commonwealth.

3—(1) The cost of undertaking, executing, carrying out, and completing the works authorised by this Act shall be defrayed out of moneys to be paid by the Commonwealth to the Treasurer for that purpose.

(2) It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to pay and apply all or any moneys received by him as aforesaid for the purposes of this Act.

Application of 44 Vict. No. 32 and 45 Vict. No. 31.

4 The provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, and the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881, shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in the schedule as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Optional application of 1 Geo. V. No. 11 or 58 Vict. No. 17.

5 At the option of the Minister any land required for the purpose of any public work authorised by this Act may be purchased, acquired or taken under the Lands Resumption Act, 1910, or the Land Vesting Act, 1894, and in the event of such option being exercised in respect of either of those Acts, for the purposes of such work, the provisions of such Act shall be deemed to be incorporated with this Act, in lieu of the provisions of the Acts mentioned in Section Four hereof.
