AN ACT to provide for the Execution of 1921. certain Public Works, and for other purposes. [14 February, 1922.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Public Works Short title. Execution Act (No. 2), 1921."
- 2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines, "the Interpretation. Minister" means the Minister for Works for the time being, and includes any person appointed by him or acting under his orders.

Public Works Execution (No. 2).

A.D. 1921.

Minister may cause works to be constructed.

3 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed, the works specified in the Schedule to this Act at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amounts set forth in the said schedule.

Appropriation for works in Schedule.

4 The cost of the said works specified in the schedule to this Act shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose.

Money not required for work may be expended by Minister on other works. 5 If the Minister at any time reports to the Governor that the whole or any portion of the money voted by this Act or any previous Act providing for the execution of public works is not required to be expended upon the work or item for which such money is voted, it shall be lawful for the Minister to expend such balance, provided it does not exceed Fifty Pounds, upon such other work or works previously authorised by Parliament, as he may think fit: Provided that such lastmentioned work is situated in the same city or municipality, as the case may be, as the work for which such money was originally voted.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32 and 45 Vict. No. 31 to be applicable.

6 All the provisions contained in "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," and "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881," shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in the Schedule to this Act as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

Land required may be acquired under 1 Geo. V. No. 11, at option of Minister. 7 Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, or any Act incorporated therewith, any land required for the purpose of any public work specified in the Schedule to this Act may at the option of the Minister be purchased, acquired, or taken under "The Lands Resumption Act, 1910," and in the event of such option being so exercised the provisions of that Act shall accordingly apply, and be deemed to be incorporated with this Act, in lieu of the provisions of "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," and "The Branch, Roads Construction Act, 1881."
