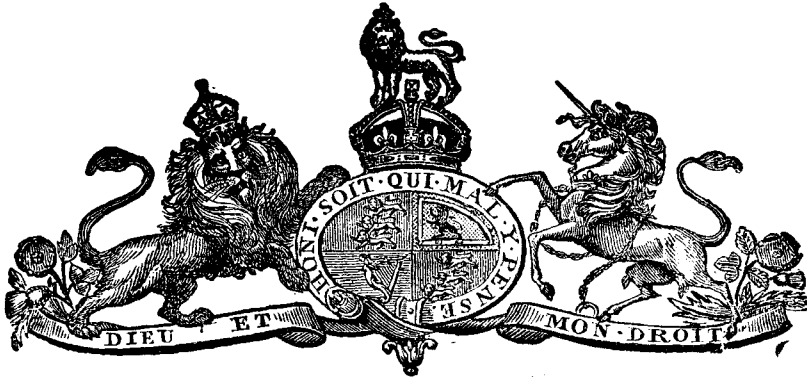

certain Public Works [16 December, 1929.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Public Works Execution Act (No. 2), 1929.” Short title.

**2** It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be undertaken, executed, purchased, and carried out the works and things referred to in Schedules (1) and (2) to this Act at a cost to the State not exceeding in the whole the sum set forth in the said schedules in respect thereof. Minister may cause works in schedules to be carried out.

**3** If any part of the money provided by this Act, or any previous Act authorising the execution of public works, is not required to be expended upon the work or item for which the same was voted, it shall be lawful for the Minister to expend such part of the said moneys as aforesaid, not exceeding in any one case a sum of Fifty Pounds, upon any other work or item which has been authorised by Parliament and which is situated in the same city or municipality as the work or item for which such money was first voted.

**4** It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to raise, borrow, and receive for the purposes of this Act any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of Fourteen thousand eight hundred and thirty Pounds Five Shillings and Four Pence.

**5** The provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, and the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881, shall extend and apply to the works mentioned in the schedules as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

**6** At the option of the Minister any land required for the purpose of any public work authorised by this Act may be purchased, acquired, or taken under the Lands Resumption Act, 1910, or the Land Vesting Act, 1894, and in the event of such option being exercised in respect of either of those Acts, for the purposes of such work, the provisions of such Act shall be deemed to be incorporated with this Act, in lieu of the provisions of the Acts mentioned in Section Five hereof.
