## AN ACT to provide for the Execution of cer- 1924. tain Public Works. [18 March, 1924.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Public Works Execution Act Short title. (No. 3), 1924."

### Public Works Execution (No. 3).

#### A.D. 1924.

Minister may cause to be con structed the works specified in the schedule.

Costs how to be defrayed.

- 2 It shall be lawful for the Minister to cause to be constructed, improved, executed, or completed the works specified in the schedule to this Act at a cost for each separate work not exceeding the amount set forth in the said schedule in respect thereof.
- 3 The cost of the said works, specified in the said schedule, shall be defrayed as follows:—
  - I. As to the sum of Twenty-five thousand Pounds, being onehalf part thereof, out of moneys granted by the Commonwealth to the State, for the development of main roads in the State; and
  - II. As to the balance thereof, being a further sum of Twentyfive thousand Pounds, out of moneys provided by Parliament for the purpose.

Provisions of 44 Vict. No. 32, and 45 Vict. No. 31, to apply.

Land may be acquired under "The Lands Resumption Act 1910."

4 The provisions of "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," and "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881," shall extend and apply to all the works specified in the schedule to this Act as fully in all respects as if the said provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

5 Notwithstanding anything contained in this or any other Act, any land required for the purpose of any of the aforesaid works may, at the option of the Minister, be purchased, acquired, or taken under "The Lands Resumption Act, 1910," and in the event of such option 1 Geo. V. No. 11. being so exercised the provisions of that Act shall accordingly apply, and be deemed to be incorporated with this Act, in lieu of the provisions of "The Public Works Construction Act, 1880," and "The Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881."
